



1. The Chair of the trustees who will ensure that selection meets the criteria set above;
2. A Trustee of the RAIC Foundation;
3. One Fellow of the College of Fellows.

The jury's decision will be final. The jury will meet by teleconference or as otherwise required to make a determination as to the recipient of the Intern/Intern Architect Fund.

Call for Submissions

The Call for Submissions will be issued by the RAIC and addressed to all Interns and Intern Architects who are RAIC Members.

Submission Criteria

Each submission must be submitted through the online submission platform and shall contain the following:

Part 1:

a summary, not to exceed two pages, of why the applicant(s) is deserving of the scholarship
illustrations or descriptions of design work, research undertaken -or any other contributions to the profession;
a brief biography (max. 2 pages for each individual or group member) - if the submission is for a team, each team member shall submit his/her biography;
three to five letters of support by those familiar with the quality of the Intern team if applicable). The letters must set out specific reasons for support.

Part 2:

Summary description of the project proposal (objectives and methodology) (Maximum 3 pages) Include a clear description of the final product, who will be the beneficiary (audience) and how it will contribute to promoting the profession to the general public.
